## AUPE CELEBRATES 62ND ANNIVERSARY!

AUPE turned 62 on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2021! Several events were held to commemorate this special occasion, starting with a meaningful AUPE x Foodbank Campaign to donate food bundles to beneficiaries under Foodbank.



#### AUPE X Foodbank - You Made It Happen!

We wanted to celebrate our 62<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary together with our members in a meaningful way by bringing smiles to needy families. For every food bundle donated by our member, AUPE will match the donation. We set an initial target of 620 food bundles and exceeded it by 234 bundles making it a whopping total of 854 food bundles, amounting to \$12,810. This wouldn't be possible without our members' generous donations and U Care Fund!

Then came the time for us to gather a total of 40 volunteers and staff to pack and do a door-to-door distribution of the food bundles at 4 locations given by Foodbank. However, nearing to the day, due to the evolving Covid situation, our initial plans were adjusted to 1 packing session to protect most of the beneficiaries who were elderlies. We were met with further challenges due to manpower constraints at one of the locations and another location were closed due to a confirmed COVID-19 case. However, these did not dampen our spirit. We looked for alternatives and finally settled with 3 locations at Eunos, Bedok & Paya Lebar. A total of 15 volunteers gathered and split into groups of 5 to pack 100 bundles at each location.

While many of us may be worried about the ongoing pandemic, there were many more people who were worried about their daily meals or putting food on the table, so I was very glad and happy that I could help in a small way to pack the food bundles donated by our members and AUPE, and to share AUPE's love with our beneficiaries. Even when we had to abide by the SMM rules, my team had fun working in a "production line" manner to do what was needed efficiently. I am looking forward to more CSR events organised by AUPE. 🚚 – Sarah Lim

#### 291 Students Benefitted from AUPE Study Grants 2021

A total of 291 students have benefitted from our AUPE Study Grant this year. A total of \$53,950, funded by AUPE, AUPE Credit Co-operative & NTUC U Care Fund were disbursed to the various levels:

Primary	66 recipients
Secondary	106 recipients
ITE / Pre-U / JC	30 recipients
Polytechnic	57 recipients
University	32 recipients

The application for AUPE Study Grant 2021 was met with great responses and we conducted an interview with 2 successful recipients to hear their thoughts on obtaining the study grants. Mdm Mathina Begum, an Operations Support Officer with Ministry of Home Affairs shared, "I am happy that AUPE has granted study



grants for our children over the years. The grant will certainly be very helpful for our next year's school expenses. My children are aware that they are receiving such grants. They wish to study as hard as they can and get a reputable job where they can contribute to their families and society."

Mdm Mathina also shared on the benefits of joining AUPE, "Being an AUPE Union member enables me to enjoy a lot of benefits such as study grants, NTUC vouchers and many others. Thank you, AUPE!"

Mr Muhammad Alif Bin Ismail, a Specialist with Immigration and Checkpoints Authority echoed the same sentiments, "AUPE Study Grants have definitely helped us financially as we can use it to purchase the children's schooling needs. ## Clocking 100KM in 2021, Together We Can!

In conjunction with the Year of Celebrating SG Women, a team of five sisters set a target for 2021 – 100KM for a Healthier Me!

After being cooped up for 56 days during the circuit breaker in 2020, this group of sisters from various branches in AUPE decided to come together to build sisterhood, and to motivate each other to have an active healthy lifestyle. They started a monthly walking meetup in October 2020 and set a goal for 2021. They wanted to clock a total distance of 100km, with a monthly walk in the different parts and parks in Singapore.

One of them may not have walked more than 5km in a single walk. Another has never thought that climbing Bukit Timah Hill was possible for her. But as a team, they encouraged and supported one another every step of the way.

At an average pace of completing 8km per month, they covered various parts of Singapore - the first ASEAN Heritage Park Sungai Buloh; along the coast of East Coast Park to the new desalination plant and the Gardens by the Bay; the rustic Imbiah Trail on Sentosa; the UNESCO Heritage site of Botanic Gardens; the sanctuary

for flora and fauna at Pasir Ris Park and Tampines Eco Green; one of the largest heartland park at Jurong Lake Gardens; basking themselves on the shores of southern islands of Singapore; up far and away from the hustle and bustle of the city at the Coney Island; escaping from the crowds at the Woodlands and Admiralty Parks; along the railway tracks at Clementi Forest and Rail Corridor; and a beautiful sunset walk at the last fishing the village and historical aerospace town in Seletar.

To end the walk for the year, the sisters chose to do a summit hike, to conquer the highest peak in Singapore, the 163m tall Bukit Timah Hill! And they accomplished their 100KM! This entire 100KM journey had been rejuvenating for all of them. Besides having a healthier lifestyle, they also saw how powerful it was when they set their minds on a goal, they make sure they do it and to do it together!

## Will Planning for NParks' Staff at Lunch Talk






