



AUPE BOWLING CHALLENGE

EVENT INFORMATION

Date: 1 June to 30 June 2022

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1 ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1 The tournament is open to both members and non-members of AUPE who are current public officers. Each team must have at least 1 AUPE member.

2 OBJECTIVE

- 2.1 This programme is organised for AUPE members and public officers to foster comradeship and maintain the spirit of goodwill, friendship and sportsmanship. The tournament shall be conducted in accordance to Singapore Bowling Rules and Regulations and Safe Management Advisory. All team members are urged to ensure that bowlers played in the spirit of the game as provided in the rules.

3 REGISTRATION OF TEAMS

- 3.1 Each team is comprised of 4 bowlers.
- 3.2 For teams with bowlers who are not AUPE members, at least one of the bowlers in the team must be an AUPE member who will also serve as the team's contact person.
- 3.3 Registration can only be done via this form:

- 3.4 An email with payment details will be sent to the team contact person. Only teams that have completed full payment by 17th June (extended date) will be allowed to participate in the Challenge Shield.
- 3.5 Registration Fee is \$120 per team.

4 DATE, VENUE & BOOKING INFORMATION

- 4.1 It will be held on **from 1 Jun to 30 Jun 2022** commencing at **Orchid Bowl @ Orchid Country Club**
- 4.2 Team is required to call **67594448** or email to orchidbowl@orchidclub.com and cc to jason_tan@orchidclub.com to book their lanes for the programme.
- 4.3 Team is required to book their session 3 days ahead of their preferred session. For this programme, as the event period will end on 30 Jun 2022, the last booking session can only be made on 27 Jun 2022.
- 4.4 Changes to booking schedule must be made 2 days before actual session. Team will only be allowed to 1 change to their booking session
- 4.5 All teams MUST report to the bowling venue at least 20 minutes before their session. **LATECOMERS WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.**
- 4.6 All practice session will be self paid.
- 4.7 Any last minutes changes will be subjected to AUPE final decision.

5 FORMAT AND PRIZES

- 5.1 The tournament will be a played based on **10 pin** format.
- 5.2 Prizes will be given for top-5 Teams; top-3 Individual High Series (Male); top-3 Individual High Series (Women);
- 5.3 Each team will be made up of 4 members and can have any mixture of male and female bowlers.
- 5.4 Female bowlers will be given a handicap of 10-pins per game (total 30 pins for 3-game series).
- 5.5 Each bowler will bowl a 3-game series and the total pin-falls (include handicaps) shall be used to determine the winners in Team and Individual prizes.

6 VERIFICATION OF SCORES

- 6.1 It is the responsibility of each bowler to verify the correctness of each game bowled by checking on the monitor console at the end of each game. Any incorrect score(s) displayed should be reported to the Tournament Officials or the bowling counter staff immediately.
- 6.2 After completing the games, bowlers will need to record their own score on manual scoresheet provided and sign on this form. Staff on duty will counter sign the scores.

7 TIES

- 7.1 In the event of a tie in the Team Event, the highest game series in the team will determine the tie-breaker. Should the difference tie again, then the highest game series will be utilised.
- 7.2 In the event of a tie in the Individual High Series, the highest game bowled will determine the tie-breaker. Should the difference tie again, then the highest game bowled will be utilised.

8 DISQUALIFICATION

- 8.1 Any form of cheating or manipulation of scores will render immediate disqualification of the bowler from further participation in this event.

9 INTERRUPTED GAME(S)

- 9.1 The Tournament Official may authorise the completion of a game or series. An important game/series that cannot be completed must resume from the point of interruption.

10 BOWLING ON WRONG LANES

- 10.1 When a bowler bowls on the wrong lane(s) and the error is discovered before the opposing bowler has bowled, a dead ball shall be declared and the bowler(s) will be required to re-bowl on the correct lane(s). If the error is not discovered until the opposing bowler has bowled, the scores shall count and the bowler shall be required to bowl his/her subsequent frame(s) on the correct lane.

11 PROTESTS AND APPEALS

- 11.1 Protest(s) involving eligibility must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Officials before the event commences.
- 11.2 Protest(s) involving errors in scoring will only be entertained if such protests are brought to the attention of the Tournament Officials / bowling centre on the spot. The Tournament Officials / bowling centre will correct errors in scoring or in calculation immediately.
- 11.3 Protest(s) involving fouls must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Officials / bowling centre before the delivery of the next ball. No protests will be entertained after the bowler has made his/her second delivery of the frame.

12 OTHERS

- 12.1 The Organising Committee reserves the right to make changes to the Rules and Regulations of this event if it is deemed necessary.

- 12.2 Tournament officials may conduct checks on all bowlers' particulars (Staff Pass and/or Identity Card).
- 12.3 The Union, Organising Committee, Tournament Officials and Orchid Bowl will **NOT** be held responsible for any theft of belongings, injury or death whatsoever caused arising from participation in this tournament.
- 12.4 If any delay or postponement of the tournament occurs as a result of circumstances beyond our control, the Organising Committee's decision as to when the tournament will resume will be treated as final.

13 SAFE MANAGEMENT MEASURES ADVISORY

- 13.1 All bowlers must be fully vaccinated
- 13.2 During the bowling session, mask must be on at all times
- 13.3 Food and Drinks are not at bowlers area except at designated area.
- 13.4 No intermingling between lanes are allowed
- 13.5 Non-bowling guests are not allowed into bowling centre

14 COLLECTION, USE AND DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL DATA

- 14.1 AUPE and/or Orchid Country Club will be retaining the data for the purpose of registration and participation in the above event
- 14.2 AUPE and/or Orchid Country Club will be contacting bowlers using contact details provided on matter relating to the event
- 14.3 AUPE and/or Orchid Country Club will be taking photograph during the event for news and publicity and may be used for print and on online/electronic platforms.
- 14.4 Where bowlers do not wish to be photograph, bowlers are required to notify AUPE and/or Orchid Bowl Centre during the event.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. Can I form a team with people from other branches/ministries/statutory boards?
You are highly encouraged to form a team from within your own branches/ministries/statutory boards. If you are unable to do so, you may write to riduan@aupe.org.sg to seek a concession to form a team with public officers from other branches/ministries/statutory boards.
2. Can non-public officers join this bowling challenge?
No, this bowling challenge is only open to current public officers. Teams with non-public officers will be disqualified with no refund on registration fees.
3. Is there a limit to the number of non-members on the team?
At least one AUPE member (OB or GB) needs to be on the team, and this person is the contact person. Other team members can be non-members.
4. How do I make the payment for registration fees?

5. Is there a limit to the number of teams each branch can send?

6. If my team get a refund of registration fees if we did not bowl in the month of June?

7. Can I change team members after registration?
Please write to riduan@aupe.org.sg with your request. You can only request for change 3 working days before the day your team is playing.
8. How will the team receive their prizes?
All prizes (monetary and others) will be handed over to the team leader who will arrange to distribute to the team. AUPE will leave it to the team to decide how they wish to distribute cash prizes.
9. Do I need to pay for parking at Orchid Country Club?
