A heartfelt thank you to our partners and expert speakers for sharing their time and knowledge to help bring this event to life. We look forward to seeing you at our next gathering!





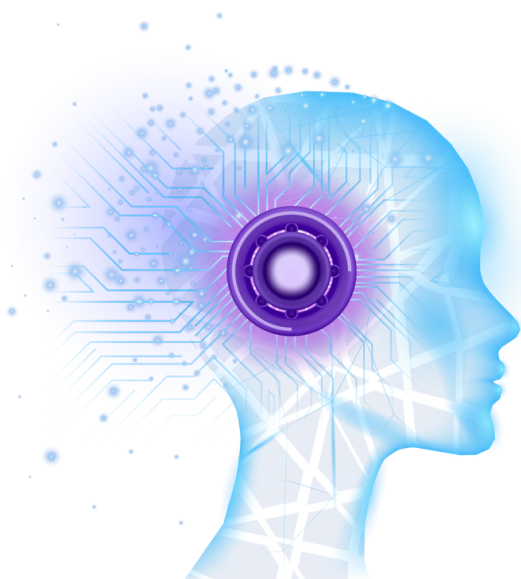

RIGHT OF PUBLIC OFFICERS TO WORK IN A SAFE SPACE

DEFENDING THE DIGNITY OF PUBLIC OFFICERS

Public officers are the backbone of our nation, working tirelessly behind the scenes to ensure our systems run smoothly. Because of the nature of their work, they are naturally susceptible to public scrutiny. However, there is a distinct line between constructive feedback and unwarranted public harassment.

A recent incident served as a reminder of how public trust can be undermined by implications that officers had not conducted their work fairly and effectively. From frontline enforcement officers and regulatory investigators to officers managing public appeals, many in public service hold roles that are exposed to external scrutiny. When facts are omitted to cast doubt on the work of public officers, it not only damages morale but undermines the trust required for them to carry out their duties effectively.

We express our support for the Minister of State, Mr. Alvin Tan, for his recent statement defending our public officers and correcting the narrative against unfounded claims about their impartiality. His underlying message is clear: officers who execute their duties diligently, without fear or favour, must be shielded from unwarranted public scrutiny.

Public officers have the right to a safe working environment and free from unwarranted public smearing. It is crucial to highlight that the Protection from Harassment Act (POHA) protects public officers from public harassment and abuse while they discharge their duties. The law is clear: the dedication of our public workforce commands respect, and their dignity must be protected.

AUPE stands in solidarity with all public officers. We are committed to supporting your well-being and your career. If you have encountered any form of workplace harassment, or if you simply need clarity on

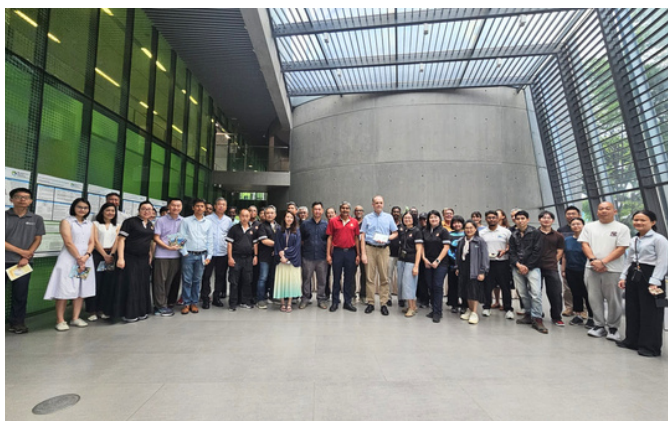
